OPS summary # USE MilTec assets of the 1 st joint-forces fleet under admiral Thomas Falcon-Rikaru, to support a SHIF wing of stealth cruisers throughout SHIF fringe territory to assess CSM-threat-lvls. Primary mission-parameter is to establish a precise threat-map for the Shiguen military forces to use in their efforts to build defenses against the forces at their southern borders.				
OPS success # positive (+)				
OPS # Initial Patrol through definitive SHIF territory without events. First signs of CSM presence in 1319-Creusa(Guanhu)-Molario(Fuikao) in Orbit. Two unknown vessels with probable CSM signatures and roughly cruiser-type size left orbit to unknown destination upon asset arrival. Comms unable to establish contact/course interdiction/destination parameters. → enhanced stealthing devices probable ←. Further patrol under alert level code “yellow”, shifts reduced to 6hrs each to enhance personnel readiness. Second CSM presence detected in 1519-Berd(Akinata)-Conis(Nhuighughen). Five unknown vessels (secured CSM sig.) of destroyer class size engaged upon asset arrival. Previous scans were without pings for CSM-forces. Initial engagement proved joint fleet hull composition and energy weaponry to be superior, though CSM destroyers were able to do some effect due to advanced projectiles and missiles as well as dependent fire solution systems. The battle ended unresolved, with the CSM-forces fleeing, again, leaving no trail to pick up by comms. Scans and intel about the ships and signatures as well as technical data, as far as available, was immediately sent to both USE and SHIF cmdn. The rest of the patrol was under alert level code “red”. Shifts remained unchanged. Patrol ended on SHIF def platform in Calia Orbit. END INITIAL SITREP SpclRep: (recommendation-promotion”wing commander”captain as well as silver star) Cpt. Bartosz, of the [USE]Ganymede did exceedingly well. Cpt. Bartosz arranged a personnel-transfer mid battle and under fire while shielding the disabled “red tiger”. This well-coordinated and selfless action did in fact result in the complete rescue of the crew of the “red tiger”. Unfortunately, it also resulted in the loss of Tech-Wing “Able” 6 men and women of the Ganymede crew that were killed via intense radiation, after a leak in the secondary reactor caused a shutdown of the respective doors. But this is a small price for the political result. The diplomatic worth aside, the tactical finesse leading to such success, convinced me to speak out this recommendation. END SPCLREP
